PAF IMPACT FUND

The PAF Impact Fund was established by the Pacific Athletics Department in 2013 and is used to support all Pacific student-athletes. The objective of the PAF Impact Fund is to reinvest all monies raised back into Pacific student-athletes and our 17 athletic programs. At the conclusion of each fiscal year, the PAF will provide all donors an "Impact Fund Report" showing where their money was used. The Impact Fund has three categories; PAF Donations, Orange & Black Ball, and PAF Premium Ticket Packages.

PAF DONATIONS

Every PAF gift will go towards supporting special projects determined by the Director of Athletics, head coaches, student-athletes, and the PAF Board. Each special project is designated to create a better environment for Pacific student-athletes, while elevating our competitiveness in athletics competition and in the classroom.

ORANGE & Black Ball

The Orange & Black Ball is the primary fundraising event of the year hosted by the PAF drawing nearly 700 guests. All funds raised go towards the Impact Fund benefiting all Pacific student-athletes.

PAF PREMIUM TICKET PACKAGES

Revenue generated from PAF Premium Ticket Packages will be combined with PAF donations and Orange & Black Ball income to make up the PAF Impact Fund.

2018 IMPACT FUND REPORT

WHAT IS THE PAF IMPACT FUND?

The PAF Impact Fund is a donation reinvestment fund that is separated into three categories (PAF Donations, Orange & Black Ball income, and PAF Premium Ticket Packages) and used to support Pacific student-athletes.Each division of the Impact Fund helps to elevate the competitiveness of Pacific Athletics in their respective sport.

HOW WILL MY DONATION BE USED THIS YEAR?

The PAF believes in investing in our student-athletes while being transparent with our donors on where the money raised is allocated each year. Last year, the PAF successfully raised \$409,883 towards the Impact Fund, which is used to enhance the Pacific student-athlete experience.

C. THE TIGER DEN

The Tiger Den is located in the end zone nearest the visitors' bench and is available exclusively to PAF Courtside Club and Damon's Circle members. It includes unlimited draught beer and wine, which can only be consumed in the Tiger Den area. The Tiger Den will be open for a minimum of 10 games throughout the season and will cost \$20/game or \$150 for the season per person.

D. PRE-GAME HOSPITALITY EVENTS

- PAF Pre-game hospitality events last an hour and a half and include food, a hosted bar, chalk-talk with men's basketball coaching staff, and opportunity to socialize with PAF members.
- All gifts to the PAF support Pacific's student-athletes. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

►I HAVE NEVER DONATED TO THE PAF, BUT I AM VERY INTERESTED. WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO RECEIVE BENEFITS FOR THE 2019-20 GIVING YEAR?

► WHY SHOULD I GIVE TO THE PACIFIC ATHLETIC FOUNDATION AND HOW WILL MY DONATION BE USED?

Every gift to the PAF is important as we strive to build and enhance our programs, raise support for our student-athletes, and compete to win championships.

► HOW DO I GET GOOD SEATS FOR MEN'S BASKETBALL GAMES AND HOW AM I GUARANTEED THE SAME SEATS?

The best seats to attend Men's Basketball games are located in the PAF Sections (H, I, or J) and floor level. The PAF Premium Ticket Package begins at \$325/seat to every men's home game. PAF Premium Ticket Packages on the floor begin at \$750/seat to every men's home game. PAF Premium Ticket Package members receive the first opportunity to guarantee the same seats or upgrade locations once they become a member.

► HOW DO I RECEIVE ACCESS TO THE PRE-GAME AND IN-GAME HOSPITALITY AREAS?

All PAF Premium Ticket Packages include access to all PAF Pre-Game hospitality events based on number of season-tickets purchased. All PAF Courtside Club Packages receive access to both pre-game and in-game hospitality areas.

► HOW CAN I GET ACCESS TO THE TIGER DEN?

Tiger Den access is available to Courtside Club and Damon's Circle members only. Members have the opportunity to purchase access on a game-by-game basis for \$20/person or purchase a full season pass at \$150.

►WILL MY DONATION BE A CHARITABLE GIFT?

All gifts to the PAF support Pacific's student-athletes and are taxdedcutible. Please be aware, however, that as of January 1, 2018, a contribution that involves the right to purchase tickets for seating at our athletic events is not deductible for federal income tax purposes. Please consult your tax advisor for further information.

► CAN I DECLINE BENEFITS?

Yes. Donors may request that no goods or benefits be received in exchange for donations to make your gift a fully charitable contribution.

PAF FUND DRIVE

The PAF helps create a well-rounded collegiate experience created for each one of our coaches and student-athletes through the contributions provided by the Fund Drive. The Fund Drive is a 6-week fundraising effort to raise funds for student-athlete enhancements for all 17 NCAA Division 1 Intercollegiate athletics sport programs at Pacific under the leadership of the Pacific Athletic Foundation (PAF).
